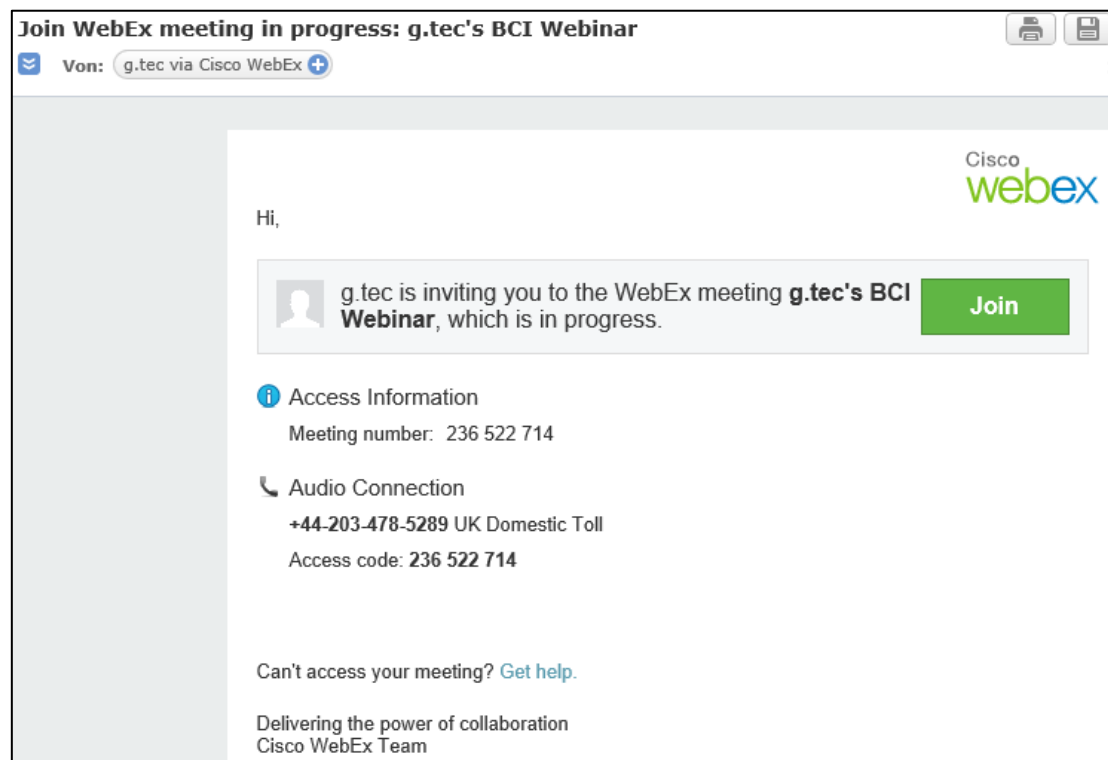




Step-by-step guide:

- 1) You have to send an e-mail to the g.tec sales agent, who will do the webinar, including your name, name of institute, postal address of your institute and phone number.
- 2) On the day of the webinar, you will get an e-mail, to the email address you registered in step 1). The e-mail looks like:



3) Please click on the “Join”-Button in the e-mail you get. This will open your web-browser and you will see a window like this:

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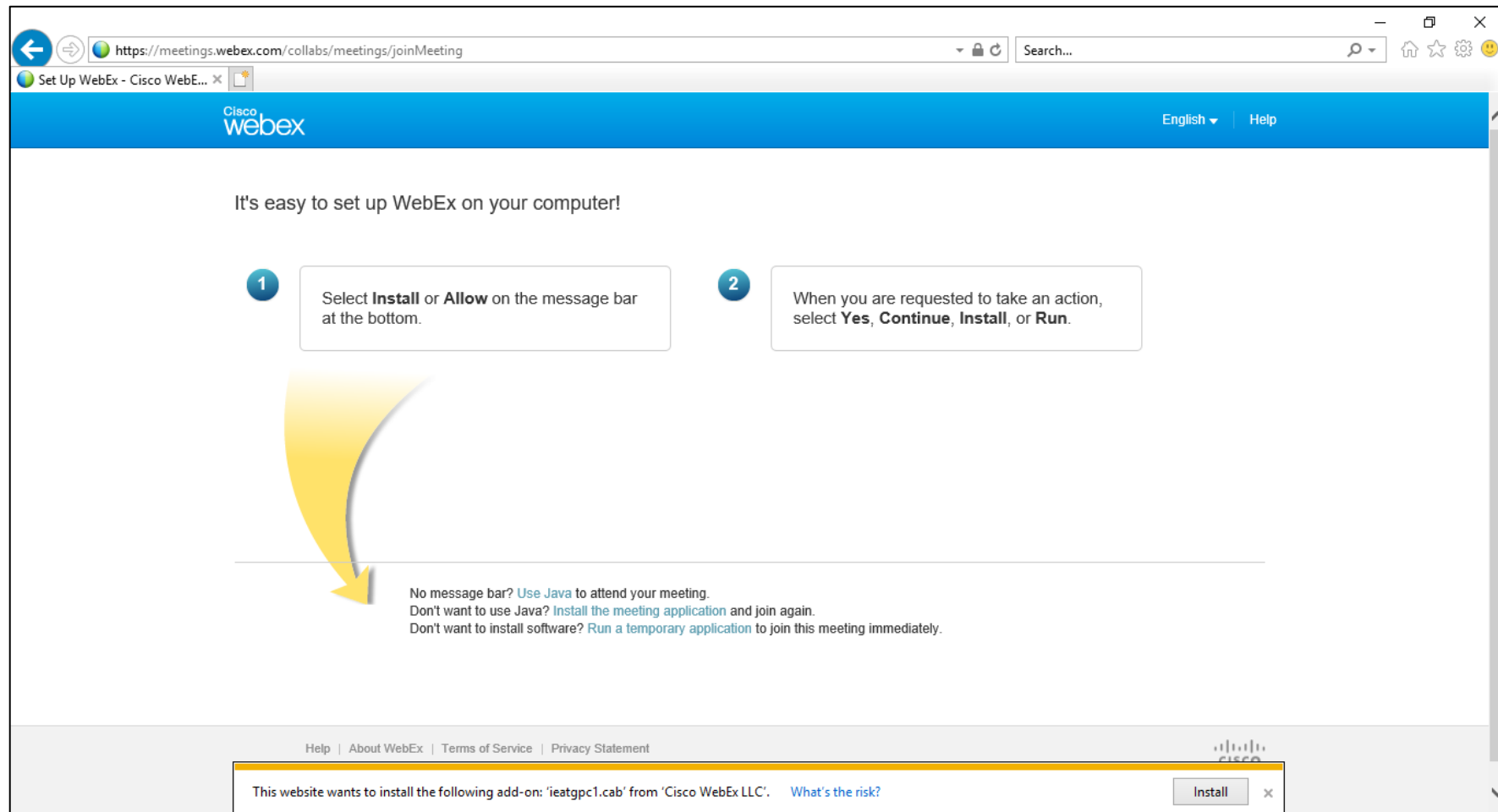
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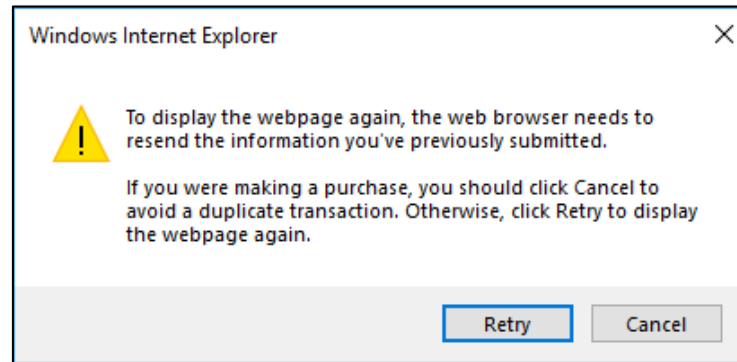


You don't need an account on Webex, but you have to add your display name and the e-mail address, you registered in step 1). When you have entered these information, please click on the “Join As Guest”-Button.

4) When you run Webex for the first time, you have to install a small add-on for your web-browser. So, you will get following window:

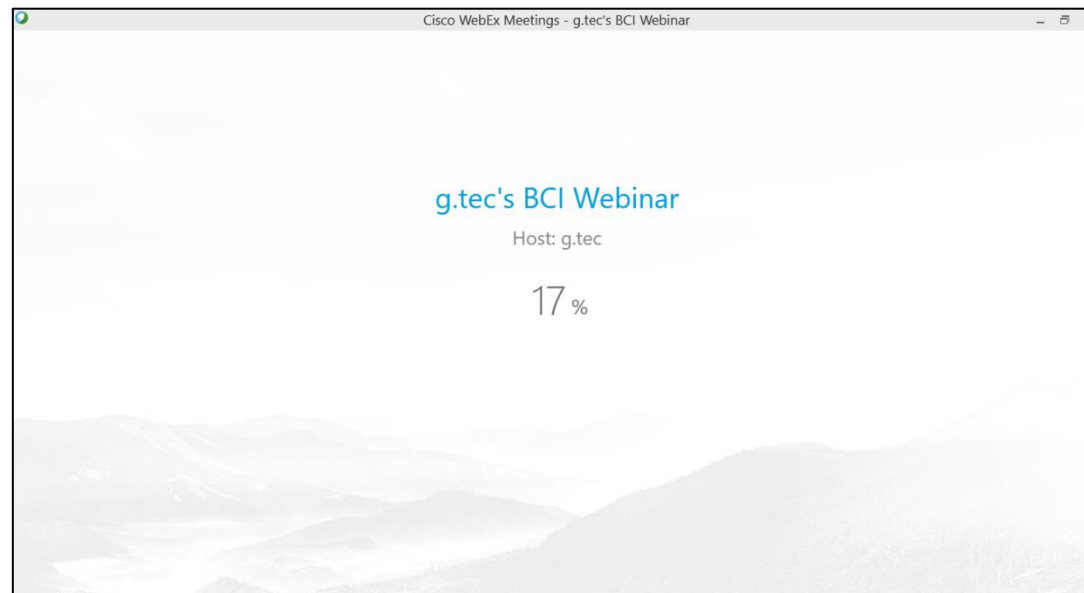


Please click on the “Install”-Button to install the Webex add-on. Probably you will get a warning of your web-browser:

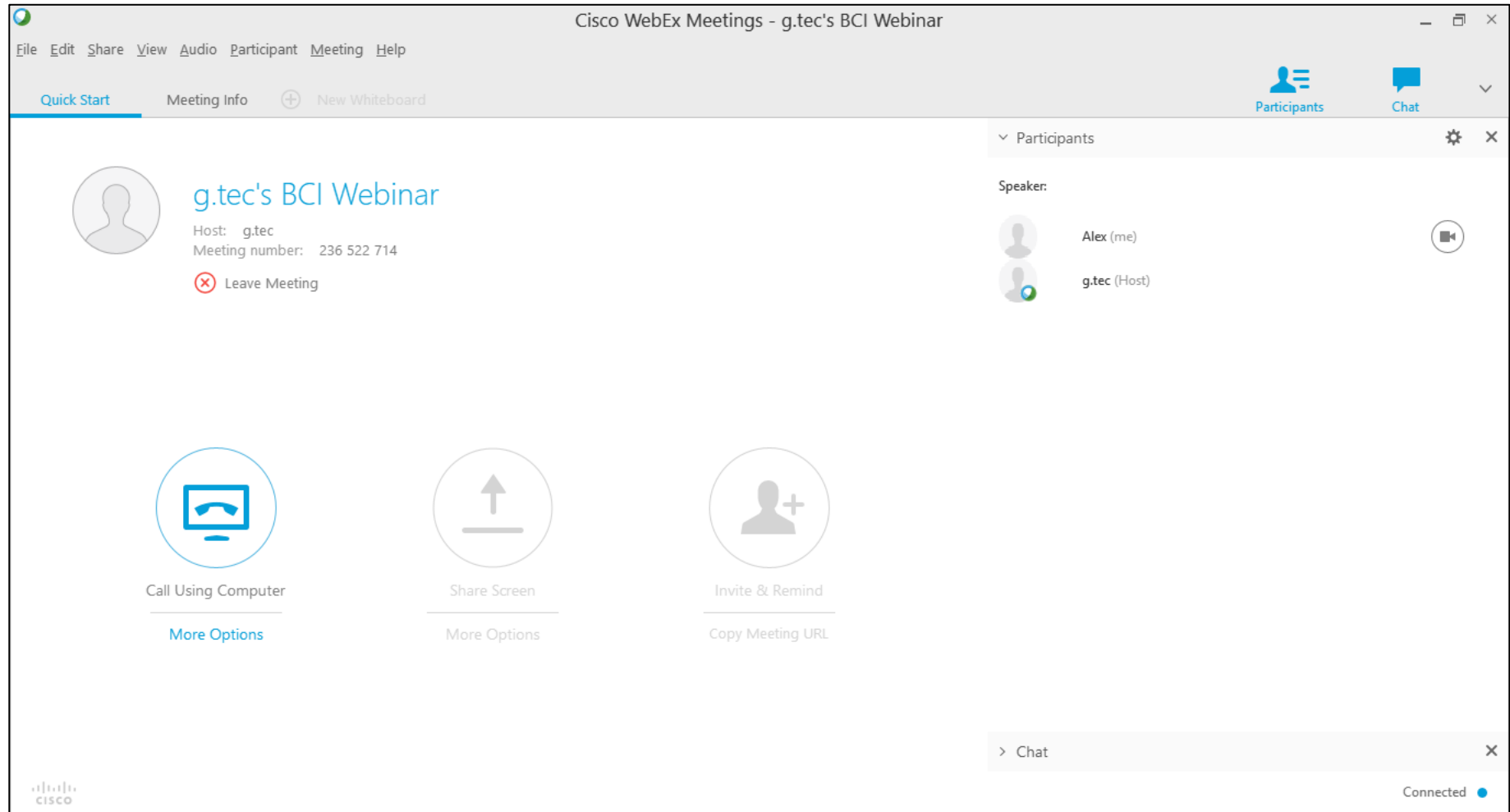


Please click on the “Retry”-button and your web-browser will show the start the Webex add-on.

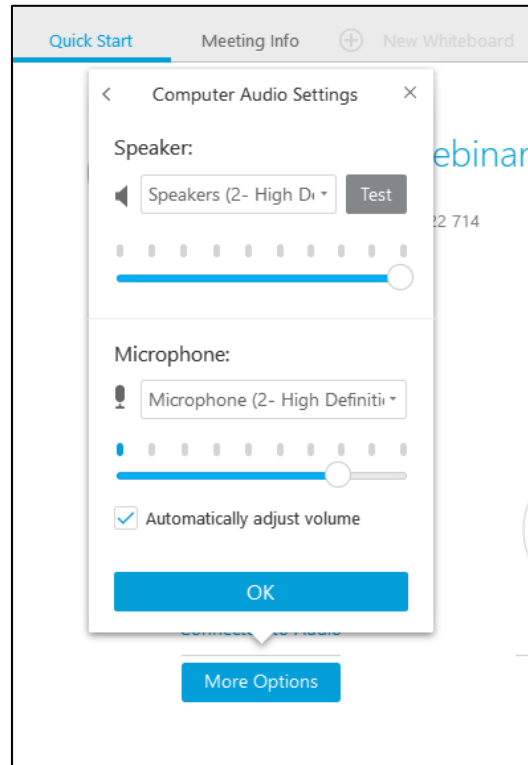
5) Starting the webinar tool might take a few seconds. You will see this screen:



6) When the Webex tool is started, you will see the main screen for the webinar:

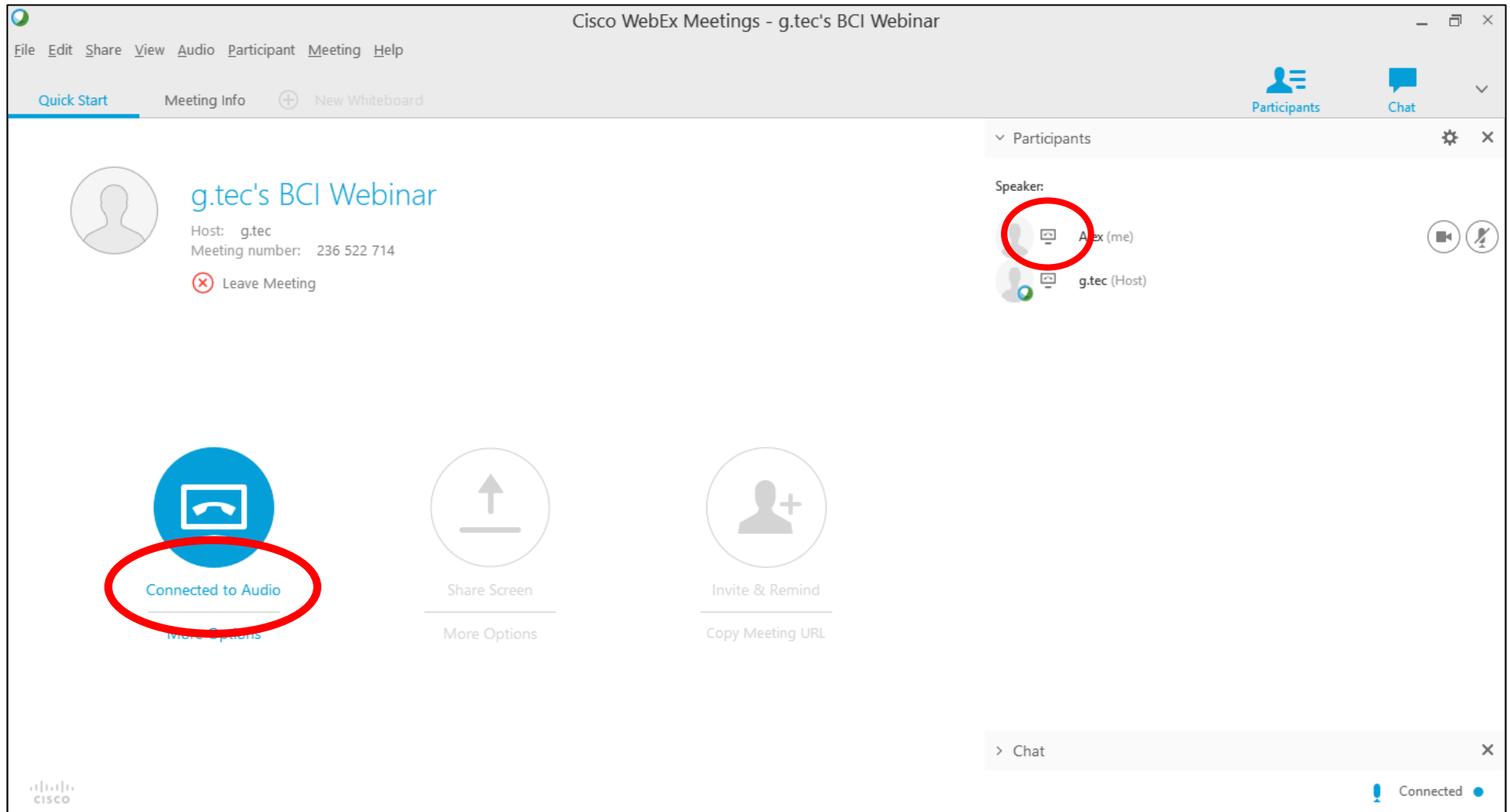


- 7) To hear the other participants, you have to activate the audio. Therefore, you can please select “Call Using Computer” and under “More Options” you can check the audio settings:




When you click the “Test”-button, you should hear a generated sound on your speakers. Further, you might have to adjust the microphone, buy moving the bar, or you can select “Automatically adjust volume”. If the settings are fine, please confirm with the “Ok”-button.

8) When you are correctly connected to audio, you should see on the screen “Connected to Audio” and also the icon beside your display name (see red circles):



9) Now you are ready and the webinar can start.

You have the option to use a video, you can write text messages to all participants or to single participants with the chat functionality also.

To reduce the noise, it is good, if you mute your microphone. Only when you want to speak, you should activate it, by clicking on the  button.
